

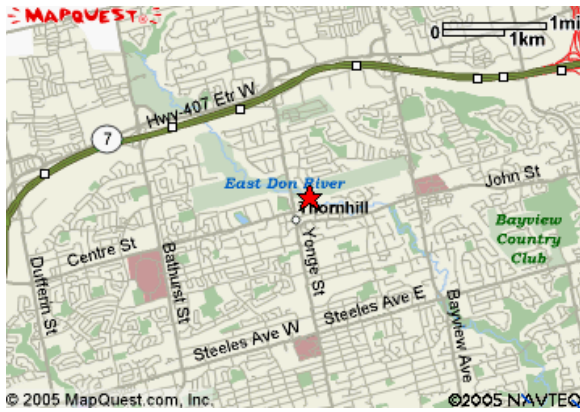


Welcome to Ladies' Golf Club of Toronto

A member or Guest Card Holder must accompany all visitors.

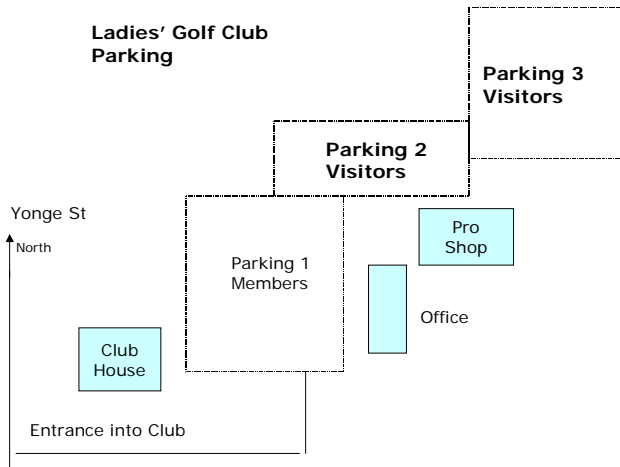
Location

We are located in Thornhill at 7859 Yonge Street, on the east side of Yonge Street, north of Centre Street and south of the 407 and Highway 7.



Parking

Visitors and Guest Card Holders may park in Lot 2 behind the Pro Shop and Lot 3 past the Pro Shop. Lot 1 outside the Clubhouse is reserved for members.



Bag Drop and Carts

Please leave golf bags at the lower level of the Pro Shop. They will be taken to the 1st tee. Power carts are available for rent at the Pro Shop. Pull carts are included in the green fee.

Locker Rooms

The Clubhouse is open for women's locker room access every day, 15 minutes before the first member tee time and closes at approximately 9 p.m., depending on member activity. If you require earlier admittance, please check with the Pro Shop. Men's locker rooms are located in the Pro Shop building.

Pro Shop

The Pro Shop is stocked with a wide range of women's golf equipment and clothing. Visa, MasterCard and Debit cards are accepted in the Pro Shop. Cash is not accepted.

Practice Facilities

Ladies' offers members and visitors excellent practice facilities, including a driving range with unlimited balls; nets, putting and chipping areas. Female guests may use the Bayview Avenue driving range for a fee of \$10 after registering with the Pro Shop. Men are permitted to use the driving range only at designated times

Pace of Play

At Ladies' we have a pace of play of 4 hours and 15 minutes for 18 holes of golf. Players are encouraged to play ready golf through the green.

Cell Phones

Cell phone use is not permitted on club property except for a medical or safety emergency. Telephones are available for your use in the Clubhouse and the Pro Shop.

Smoking

Ladies' has a non-smoking policy in its indoor restaurants and facilities. Guests may smoke cigarettes on the veranda, balcony and patio areas. Pipe and cigar smoking are prohibited.

Washrooms

Ladies' and men's washrooms are located at the Pro Shop, the Halfway House at the 9th tee, and near the 6th green. Sunscreen, hand lotion and other amenities are supplied.

Refreshments

Snacks are available at the Halfway House at the 9th tee. After the game, you can enjoy fine dining in our fully licensed Clubhouse restaurant, have a casual meal in the Garden Room, or enjoy the outdoor patio area and lawns. We only accept VISA, MasterCard and Debit cards in the Clubhouse. Cash is not accepted.

Dress Code

Ladies' celebrates the heritage of the game. To us, that translates into a simple dress code, attention to course etiquette and good sportsmanship. We ask that members and their guests be appropriately dressed at all times while on the course, grounds and clubhouse. Golf attire should be neat, tailored and consistent with the standards of the club and tradition of the game of golf.

Our dress code is strictly enforced and members are responsible to ensure that their guests follow these rules.

On the Golf Course

Women (all ages):

Conservative, tailored slacks, golf skirts, shorts

Socks should be knee high or no more than 2 inches above the ankle.

Proper soft spike golf shoes

Men (all ages):

Tailored slacks or Bermuda shorts.

Shirts with both a collar and sleeves and tucked in at all times

Socks should be knee high or no more than 2 inches above the ankle.

Proper soft spike golf shoes

Prohibited Dress:

Denim apparel in all colours

Racer backs, tank tops or halters

Front of shirt must not descend below the collar bone

Bare midriffs in standing position

Large or indiscrete logos are not acceptable

Cargo pants with buckles and ties

Stirrup pants

Warm up suits

Pull-on drawstring shorts/slacks

Skirts/shorts that are more than 5 inches above the knee or less than 18 inches when measured from the bottom of the waistband.

Hats worn backwards

Clubhouse, Dining Rooms/Dining Areas

Members, Guest Card Holders and Guests are required to dress appropriately in all areas. Use smart casual attire as a guideline. Golf attire as outlined above is permissible in all areas. Men are required to remove hats/headgear before entering the Clubhouse.
