GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Free relief)

Relief **MAY** be taken from marked areas and graveled French drains. Relief **MUST** be taken from staked young trees, clubhouse patio area and any cultivated flower beds.

OUT OF BOUNDS

- Defined by property fencing and white stakes.
- Practice range between holes 11 & 12.
- Hole 18 out of bounds on the right side of the driveway beyond the bridge.
- Hole 8A out of bounds on the north (right) side of the paved path.

DROP AREAS

Drop areas provided on holes 4 (for ball entering pond on right only), 7, 8A, 13 and 16 (for balls that have cleared the river) **MAY** be used under penalty of one stroke. No Penalty Exceptions - Drop area on 7 if ball comes to rest on ledge rock.

PACE OF PLAY

18-hole round should be played in 4 hours and 10 minutes or less.

MAXIMUM SCORE PER HOLE

NET double bogey may be counted as your maximum score per hole under the World Handicap System.

ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE & DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS

In non-tournament rounds (including match play), you **MAY**, under penalty of two strokes, proceed under Rule 14.3 rather than proceed under stroke and distance. A detailed handout on this procedure is available in the Golf Shop.

HAZARD STAKES

Double red or yellow stakes indicate the start or end of a hazard

Lightning Alarm

A single, continuous siren/horn blast indicates that play is suspended immediately. Golfers must return to the clubhouse, golf shop, maintenance facility, vehicles, or take shelter in one of the on-course rain shelters or the Halfway House. An intermittent horn/siren blast will indicate that lightning has not been detected for 20 minutes and play may resume.

Rain Shelters

Behind 6th green, between 14th tee and 8a tee, to the right of 9th forward tee deck

Washrooms

Between 3rd, 7th and 14th hole, Halfway House, and Golf Shop.
